MEMORANDUM FOR NJ WING MEMBERS

SUBJECT: Use of Red or Blue Vehicle Emergency Warning Lights.

1. Civil Air Patrol Regulation 77-1 prohibits the use of red or blue vehicle emergency warning lights on any Civil Air Patrol vehicles.
2. After a review of past New Jersey Wing policy and of current Civil Air Patrol regulations it has been determined that there is no valid reason to authorize use of red or blue vehicle emergency warning lights on personally owned vehicles in New Jersey.
3. Red or blue vehicle emergency warning lights are not authorized for use by any Civil Air Patrol member for any Civil Air Patrol purposes by New Jersey Wing.
4. Permits for red or blue vehicle emergency warning lights are no longer being issued or renewed for Civil Air Patrol members by the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission. The process to remove the existing application form on the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission website is underway but takes some time. No Civil Air Patrol member should use this application or in any way apply for these lights as a Civil Air Patrol member.
5. Civil Air Patrol members who hold valid red or blue vehicle emergency warning lights issued for use by other official emergency service or law enforcement agencies in New Jersey are not affected by this memorandum provided that they do not in any way use these lights when performing duties as a member of Civil Air Patrol.
6. Compliance with this directive is mandatory.
